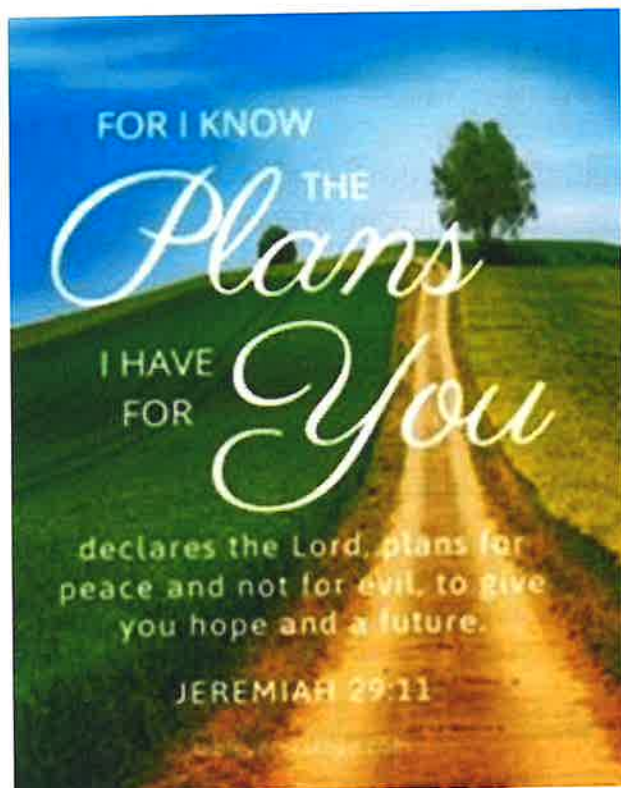

Thinking of you and praying for you.

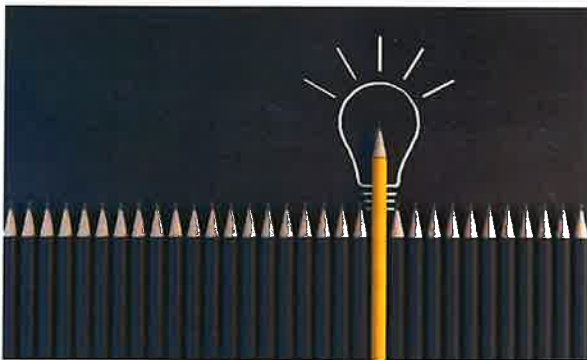
